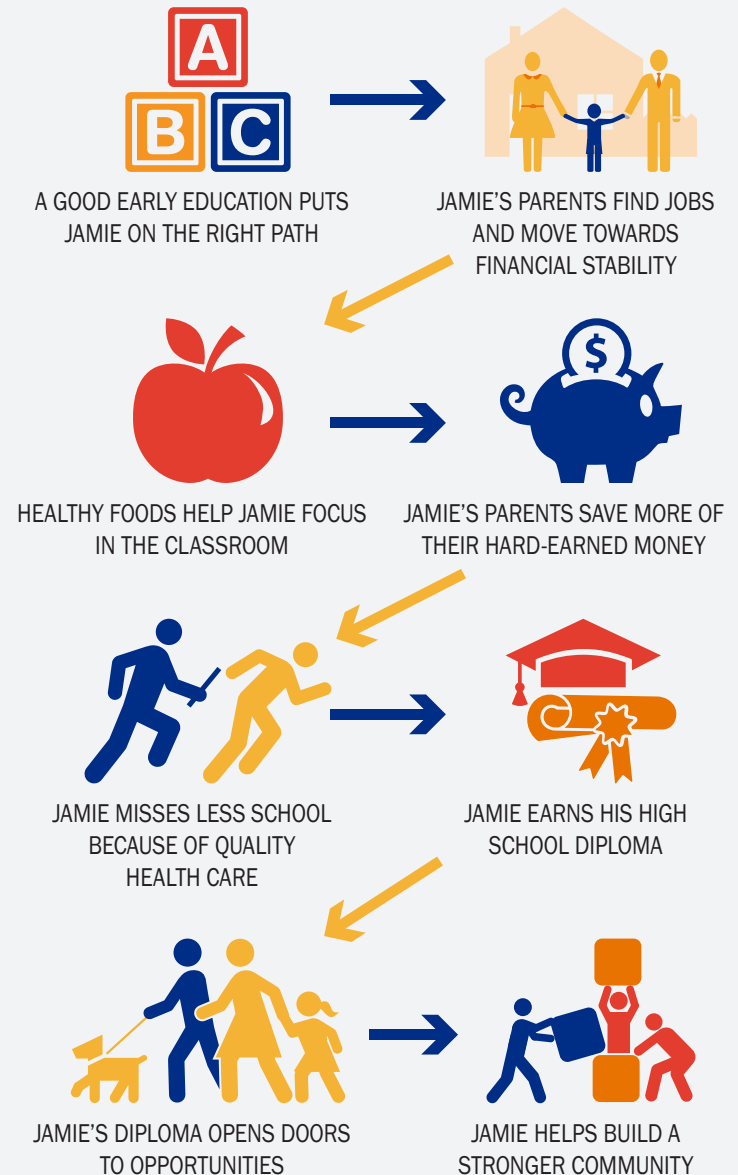

Gulf Coast Center for Nonviolence – Adrienne’s House



\$100/week (\$5,200/year):
Provides an individual with emergency shelter and support services.

American Red Cross of Southeast MS



\$11.60/week (\$605/year):
Provides financial assistance for a family impacted by a home fire or disaster, helping them purchase food, clothing, or other critical needs.

Boys & Girls Clubs of Jackson County



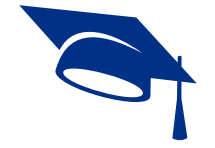
\$50/week (\$2,600/year):
Provides membership for 8 children (ages 5 – 18) to attend after-school and summer programs.

United Way Community Resources Center



\$5/week (\$260/year):
Provides 1 month of utility or power assistance for 2 senior citizens.

Home of Grace



\$58/week (\$3,000/year):
Provides a half scholarship for a man or woman enrolling in a 90-day addiction recovery program.

Jackson County CASA



\$20/week (\$1,040/year):
Provides resources for one 30-hour training session for CASA volunteers.

Catholic Charities of South MS



\$1/week (\$52/year):
Provides household items for an abused woman to make a new home for her and her family.

MS Gulf Coast YMCA



\$100/week (\$5,200 a year):
Provides opportunities for 104 children to participate in before and after-school care programs.

Prevention and Safety Services (PASS)



\$50/week (\$2,600/year):
Provides 59 car seats for children.

Health and Prescription Services



\$100/week (\$5,200/year):
Provides one 30 day supply of insulin for a diabetic patient.

Gulf Coast Center for Nonviolence – Rape Crisis Program



\$50/week (\$2,600/year):
Provides weekly counseling sessions for an adult or child victim of sexual assault for 6 months.

Singing River Services



\$20/week (\$1,040/year):
Provides 1 week of support and on-the-job training to 15 intellectually disabled adults.

- Served 97 adults and 57 children through 4,211 nights of emergency shelter and 12,633 meals
- Provided 212 individual counseling sessions and 403 group sessions

Boys & Girls Clubs of Jackson County



BOYS & GIRLS CLUBS
OF JACKSON COUNTY

- Provided a 10 month after-school program and a 7 week summer program
- Taught character and leadership development, education and career development, health and life skills, arts, sports, fitness, recreation and technology to youth between the ages of 5 and 18
- Recorded an annual enrollment of 672 youth, with an average daily attendance of 318 youth
- Administered the Workforce Program and hired a total of 12 high school and college students for the after-school and summer programs
- Provided 3 "Youth of the Year" college scholarships for a total of \$2,000 and 2 "Continue Your Education" scholarships for a total of \$1,000

Jackson County CASA



- Provided 8,438 volunteer hours of direct services by nearly 100 CASA volunteers
- Advocated for more than 200 abused and neglected children
- Reunited 30 children with their families; 34 children found loving and forever homes through adoption and/or durable legal custody
- Helped "Change a Child's Story" for more than 70% of the children in custody due to abuse and neglect

MS Gulf Coast YMCA



- Taught a total of 471 Ocean Springs' third graders water safety education, as well as free swim lessons; 506 children and adults received water safety education and swim lessons; and 147 children received free water safety education and free swim lessons
- Awarded \$109,346 in scholarships to 549 individuals through before/after-school camp summer camp, preschool and membership services
- Delivered games and activities to promote health and learning to children in underserved areas through Y on the Fly. Each visit incorporated engaging activities focused on physical play, STEM, water safety and character development. The Y on the Fly provided services to 1,950 children in 39 locations.

Prevention and Safety Services (PASS)



- Taught 10 weeks of Too Good for Drugs classes to more than 2,000 children in Jackson County (grades 6-8)
- Provided 312 car seats through rental/loaning/donation to clients in Jackson and George counties (an average of 26 per month)
- Distributed safety information to 1,500 parents and children through community awareness events and programs
